October 26, 2022, The Oakley City Council motioned that they are in favor of working with Deer Meadow Enterprises LLC on the development of the city-owned property on the northside of Center Street.

This motion from City Council only provides opportunity for developer to submit a master usage by 35.8% during planned development application to Oakley City. Once an application is submitted, the lengthy and thorough process will begin with 8.5% for the summer of Planning Commission and will be publicly noticed as appropriate.
